



KAPI Association's Policy and Procedure for Selecting Partners

Küresel Eşitlik ve Kapsayıcılık Ağı Derneği (KAPI) collaborates with local, thematic, and technical stakeholders to enhance social impact. If sub-partners are to be involved in project implementation, the following policy and procedures apply:

1. Partnership Principles

- Partner organizations must align with KAPI's values of gender equality, human rights, and participatory governance.
- Partnerships aim to facilitate mutual learning, strengthen local capacities, and improve access to target groups.
- All collaborations are governed by clear, transparent, and accountable agreements or protocols.

2. Partner Selection Process

- Potential sub-partners may be identified through open calls, direct invitation, or previous collaborations.
- Evaluation criteria include: institutional track record, experience in the relevant thematic area, access to target communities, and adherence to ethical and transparency standards.
- A standardized "Partnership Evaluation Form" approved by the Executive Board is used for assessment and decision-making.

3. Contracting and Implementation

- A formal agreement is signed with selected partners, outlining project scope, division of responsibilities, budgetary management, and reporting requirements.
- Activities of the partner are regularly monitored, and technical support is provided as needed.
- Roles and obligations of both parties are clearly defined.

4. Fraud Prevention and Ethical Compliance

- All partners must commit to complying with UN Women's Anti-Fraud and Ethical Conduct Policies.
- Any indication of misconduct triggers internal review and, if necessary, termination of the partnership.
